On behalf of the International Union of Notaries, I wish to inform you herewith officially that the General Meeting of member Notariats of our Union convened in Algiers on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2012 has adopted unanimously the following resolution, expressing its favourable vote to the admission of Notary Chamber of Montenegro as a member to UINL.

*The General Meeting of Member Notariats of U.I.N.L., convened in Algiers on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2012, unanimously recognises the Notary Chamber of Montenegro as the official body representing the Chamber of Notaries of the Republic of Montenegro and admits it as member of the International Union of Notaries with all ensuing rights and privileges.*

We appreciated very much your attitude during your approach to the Union. You showed great spirit of collaboration and responsibility that will bring you fruitful results.

The International Union of Notaries welcomes you and your colleagues of Montenegro to the family of the world notariat !

Your Chamber of Notaries is now full member of the UINL.

Your Chamber of Notaries is also a member of the European Affairs Commission (CAE) of our Union. I will ask the President of the CAE, Mr Mario MICCOLI to contact you in order to define your participation in this prestigious Commission.

I wish to inform you that the member Notariats of UINL are entitled to propose one or more candidates to the post of general councillor for the next 2014-2016 legislature. You may already submit such a candidature which will be taken into consideration by the next General Meeting of member Notariats to be held in October 2013.

UINL is also composed of different intercontinental Commissions. You, as President, and your Notariat may propose colleagues who wish to participate in the following intercontinental Commissions: Notarial Social Security Commission; Notarial Ethics Commission; Human Rights Commission; Themes and Congresses Commission.

For your information, the Commissions of the Union meet at least twice a year, generally alongside the meetings of the General Council, Steering Committee or General Meeting of member Notariats. According to art. 38 of the Bye-Laws, the member Notariats of UINL are required to financially support their delegates on the commissions and working groups of UINL in an appropriate manner and throughout their terms of office.

Please find enclosed the Statutes and Bye-laws of the Union and the lists of member Notariats, General Council and Steering Committee for the 2011-2013 legislature. In the Bye-laws you will find the articles referring to the mentioned Commissions.
